### Topic 1: HSO Update

Phyusin provided an update on the Food Access FIOC investment work. And briefed CAC on upcoming deliverables (reports) to OHA (HEP &CAC demographic). Rebecca also provided an overview on HRSN (Health-related Social Needs) and the targeted populations for this benefit.
